Institute for Demographic Research of FCTAS RAS and Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MGIMO University), Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation, invite you to participate in XII International scientific and practical forum **«Migration bridges in Eurasia: global and regional dimensions»**.

The Forum will be held at the MGIMO University on **December 15 – 16, 2020**.

The main tasks of the Project:

- 1) the unification of scientists, experts, and practitioners engaged in research and practical regulation of migration in the countries of the world;
- 2) expert evaluation and implementation of effective approaches and practices in migration management in the migration policy of Russia and partner countries;
- 3) development of the international research network of experts in the field of migration studies;
- 4) activation of research activities of young researchers in the field of migration at the international level;
- 5) the formation of a positive image of Russia as a country regulating migration based on national legislation and interstate agreements.

The main topics of the Forum for round tables and expert panels:

- Problems and prospects of human capital development in the era of the COVID-19 pandemic (supported by the World-class Scientific Center of MGIMO University);
- Health of migrants during the COVID-19 pandemic;
- Educational migration and academic mobility;
- Migration and economic development;
- Global climate change and migration;
- Problems of adaptation and integration of migrants in Russia and foreign countries.

No conference fee is charged for participation in the Forum. Organizers do not cover travel and accommodation expenses but provide organizational and visa support for participants.

In a difficult epidemiological situation, participants will have an opportunity to connect Forum via Zoom. The link will be sent to the participants with the final program of the Forum, and will also be posted on the websites of the IDR FCTAS RAS and MGIMO University a few days before the start of the event.

Working languages: Russian and English; simultaneous interpretation will be provided.

FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS FOR PAPERS

The article should be presented as a Word document in Russian or English.

Length of the Paper should be (including the title, annotation, keywords, main text, references) 10-15 pages (for standard paper A4). Lettering in Times New Roman, font size 14 pt with 1.5-line spacing, justifying text on a page. First-line indentation – 1,25 cm.

The title of a Paper, full names of authors, academic degree, work position, place of work, email address, abstract, keywords should be provided **both in Russian and English**.

All figures should be in black and white colors, clearly legible and editable. The text in the table: single line spacing, font size 12 TNR.

References should include all works cited or mentioned in the text of the proceedings. Reference should be given in the sequential order in which they first appear.

If necessary, a reference is made to the grant. It should be indicated after the title of the article and given in italics.
