 - Digitalization of social and political life: advantages, risks and treats;
 - Security and solidarity between liberal democracy and new authoritarianism.

Information For Authors

All manuscripts submitted to the journals should be original work that has not been published before or submitted for publication elsewhere without plagiarism and unethical research.

The editors accept materials up to 30 thousand print marks in an electronic format version of Word for Windows. Complete article includes the following information in Russian and English languages:

- the article title;
- abstract (200–250 words);
- keywords;
- information about the author (authors) the surname, name and patronymic, the official name of the current place of employment, academic degree, title, e-mail address.

The author must indicate the sources of all cited in the article quotes, numbers, and other information. The abbreviations are explained.

References must be given for all academic works which influenced the research in some way. All borrowed content must be quoted according to rules of citing with reference to author and source. Manuscript does not contain any unformatted quotes. Unformed quotes and assignment of rights to other people's research results are unacceptable.

References to sources are made in the form of endnotes. References to the source in square brackets are indicated in the text: [21, p. 37]. Bibliographic descriptions of publications issued in accordance with state standards.
