INFORMATION LETTER

On November 16-18, 2020, Moscow will host the first Russian-Iranian sociological forum (hereinafter referred to as the Forum), which will be supported by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation.

Russian-Iranian interaction within the framework of the Forum, organized on the initiative of the Institute for Socio-Political Research and the Institute for Demographic Research of the FCTAS RAS, is designed to unite Russian and Iranian scientists to discuss issues related to social, socio-economic and demographic aspects of the development of the Russian Federation and the Islamic Republic of Iran in the context of world development and global challenges (including the COVID-19 pandemic).

The Forum will be organized in the form of plenary reports, where academicians, corresponding members of the Russian Academy of Sciences, leading Russian and Iranian sociologists and demographers are scheduled to speak. The forum is unique in that young scientists and researchers from Iran and Russia will have the opportunity to listen to the reports of outstanding Russian and foreign scientists representing scientific schools and areas of sociological science.

The Forum program also provides for the holding of the International Academy of Young Sociologists for young scientists of Iran and Russia, within the framework of which the following events will be held:

- 1) Project session. It includes presentations by leading and young scientists on research projects supported by Russian foundations and international organizations;
- 2) International sociological workshop, where leading social scientists conduct master classes for young researchers on the topics "Statistical indicators and methods in sociological research" and "development of tools for sociological research: a survey method in the case of studying the economic behavior of young people"; as well as special scientific sessions for young scientists of social Sciences and Humanities "the Caspian region: the potential of scientific communication" and "youth of Greater Eurasia today: the potential for cooperation and interaction".

Scientists, representatives of government bodies, mass media, civil society organizations, postgraduates and students are invited to participate in the Forum.

The publication of the forum materials in Russian and English is planned.

Requirements to registration of abstracts

MS word, page format A4, font size 14, Times New Roman, all margins – 2.0 cm, spacing of 1.5 cm. The publication volume is up to 10 pages. Materials exceeding the specified amount will be reduced at the discretion of the organizing committee's program group.

In the text, references to scientific sources are given in square brackets (for example: [1], [1-5; 9]). They are numbered in the order they are mentioned in the text. Footnotes to official and reference sources are allowed.

The text of the article shouldn't contain "bold" font and underscores, italics are allowed.

UDC, article title (bold), initials, surname (bold), scientific title, place of work (University/organization), position, e-mail, text abstract and keywords – all in Russian and English.

Abstract content no more than 50 words; separated by spaces; alignment – width; interval 1.5 cm; here and in the text automatic indent ("red line") – 1.25 cm.

Keywords: words and phrases – no more than 10.

The list of references is provided in Russian and English. Sources are placed in the order they are mentioned in the text.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select the submitted materials.
