The Chinese model of modernization and its impact on the further development of the world community

The established Chinese model of modernization has convincingly proved its viability, revealed the advantage of socialism with Chinese characteristics, and confirmed that modernization does not necessarily mean "Westernization".

The main features of the Chinese modernization model

The Chinese model of modernization affects a third of the world's population, which includes 56 nationalities and is located on a vast territory with large regional differences. The process of modernization in China began in conditions when the country was completely impoverished and torn by war. Nevertheless, this process turned out to be quite successful, even compared to most other countries, and allowed China to achieve great success in many areas: economy, social sphere, interethnic relations, etc.

The Chinese model of modernization also involves the integration of material and spiritual components based on the principles of humanism.

Another important feature of this model is to ensure harmony between man and nature. Over the past 10 years, China has radically changed its attitude to the problem of environmental protection in order to curb its destruction. And today, China is making great efforts to develop a low-carbon economy in order to reduce carbon dioxide emissions into the atmosphere.

The uniqueness of the Chinese modernization model is based on the fact that Chinese society under the leadership of the Communist Party of China has managed to maintain its independence based on the national characteristics of the country. Thanks to this, 1.4 billion people live in a prosperous country today, which has undoubtedly become an important contribution to the development of the world community. This serves as an important guideline for the modern system of global governance.

And finally, the Chinese model of modernization has a great influence on the process of peaceful development of the world community, which meets the fundamental interests of both China and the whole world. China has always advocated and stands for peaceful development, cooperation and mutual benefit, and calls on the international community to jointly build a community with a common future. China's history and culture convince us that it will never follow the path of those countries that are ready to use such means as war, unilateral sanctions, colonization and plunder.

The global significance of the Chinese modernization model

Today's system of international relations is experiencing a clear deficit of justice and solidarity with an excess of division or confrontation. No country should

assume the role of a judge and use slogans about the violation of the principles of democracy and human rights as a pretext for interfering in the internal affairs of other countries or hindering their development. The purposes and principles of the UN Charter should be respected by all, and cooperation between States should be based on equality and mutual respect.

In recent years, the world community has experienced an unprecedented negative impact of serious transformations, including the Covid pandemic, the financial and economic crisis, the energy transition, etc. The result of this was the growth of unilateralism and protectionism and a slowdown in the processes of economic globalization. Xi Jinping proposed to accelerate the formation of a new development paradigm, which is based on internal treatment, BUT domestic and international treatment complement each other, and noted that the essence of the new development paradigm is to realize a high level of independence. This sheds light on the path that will lead China to economic modernization at a new stage of development, and is of great and far-reaching importance for ensuring China's qualitative economic and social development and global economic prosperity.

It is important that under these conditions, Chinese leader Xi Jinping proposed a new paradigm of world development leading to global economic prosperity based on a combination of industrialization, informatization, urbanization and modernization of agriculture. Developing countries that embarked on the path of modernization after the Second World War faced serious difficulties due to the fact that the established international political and economic system was based on the dominance of developed Western countries.

The Chinese model of modernization, which rejects the traditional Western model of modernization based on the support and development of capital through external expansion and plunder, shows developing countries a new way of modernization that will allow humanity to create a more effective social system. The Chinese experience of reforms proves that there is no single model of modernization, and each country has the opportunity to develop its own model that better suits its national characteristics.

The existing gap between developed and developing countries is a serious incentive and driving force for accelerating modernization, but it does not lead to their refusal to follow an independent path of development.

The impact of the Chinese modernization model on the global management system

The Chinese model of modernization in the Chinese style is based on openness and following the key trends of globalization and the progress of human society. As a leading developing country, China plays the role of a key force promoting economic globalization based on openness, inclusiveness, balance and mutual benefit.

Having put forward a number of initiatives, including the ***One Belt, One Road*** project, the ***Global Development Initiative***, a call for **radical reduction of CO2** emissions by 2030 and achieving ***Carbon neutrality*** by 2060, as well as taking

concrete steps to implement them, China has acted as a responsible international actor acting in the interests of building a community with a common the future.

January 1, 2023 marked the first anniversary of the entry into force of the ***Comprehensive Regional Economic Partnership*** (CREP) to create the world's largest free trade area, which was signed by 15 countries of the Asia-Pacific region, including China. In 2022, the CREP provided key support to regional trade: from January to August, trade between China and the remaining 14 members of the CREP reached \$1.2 trillion (about 8.32 trillion yuan), or 30.5% of its total foreign trade turnover.

The Belt and Road Project initiated the implementation of a number of landmark investment projects that will create new growth drivers for the economies of those countries that participate in it. For example, the Jakarta-Bandung high-speed railway connecting the capital of Indonesia Jakarta and the city of Bandung, after the commissioning of which the development of many countries of Southeast Asia will significantly accelerate. Today, China is helping African countries to develop agriculture to fight poverty.

In addition to the One Belt, One Road project, China has launched the ***Global Development Initiative*** (GDI) and the ***Global Security Initiative*** (GSI), which offer a new vision of building a human community with a common future to ensure its peaceful and prosperous development for present and future generations. The President of the British Institute for East-West Strategic Studies, J.K. von Pfetten, said in this regard that "*the GDI and GSI proposed by China invite all countries of the world to participate in them in order to support the desire of the world community for peace and sustainable development.*"

Vice-chairman of the British club 48 Group K. Bennett argues that "*the modernization of a small number of Western countries was based on the exploitation, oppression and colonization of almost the rest of the world. China is not developing at the expense of exploiting any other countries, while developing and modernizing, it is simultaneously helping other countries to develop and modernize. China's pursuit of universal prosperity is an important lesson not only for developing countries, but also for developed countries.*"
